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**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA ENTERING INTO A REIMBURSEMENT  
AGREEMENT WITH THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION, AS A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE  
FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION, FOR  
TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM GRANT  
FUNDING FOR THE TOOKANY CREEK TRAIL PHASE III  
PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING SIGNATORIES FOR THE  
AGREEMENT**

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**WHEREAS**, Cheltenham Township applied for and received grant funding under the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT)'s Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) in the amount of \$700,000 (grant) for the construction of Tookany Creek Trail Phase III (through Gimbel Field between Harrison Avenue and New Second Street); and

**WHEREAS**, this grant will reimburse the Township for 100% of allowable construction costs up to \$693,000 of this trail project; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant will be allocated to the construction of the bridge crossing over the Tookany Creek near New Second Street and rough grading the trail to provide access to the site where the bridge will be installed; and

**WHEREAS**, the design portion of the project is nearing completion and the project is slated to be let in July 2020; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township hereby:


- 1) Agrees to enter into a Reimbursement Agreement with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the TAP grant-funded of the Tookany Creek Trail Phase III; and
- 2) Designates the Township Manager and Assistant Township Manager to electronically sign the Reimbursement Agreement in PennDOT's RAS.
