Notice of Scheduled Work**

Dear Mike:

This letter is intended to notify you of some upcoming work that is planned on Sanitary Sewer Interceptor A. Aqua will be televising the downstream portion (7,500 LF) of the interceptor from Manhole A-32 to MC-2 (PWD Entry Point). We have sent notices to the landowners, namely the JC Melrose Country Club and the Fairmount Park Conservancy.

The work must be performed at night when the flow in the sewer lines are at the lowest (i.e. lowest water usage period of the day). If the area receives rain prior to the scheduled start date and/or during the work period, then the work might be delayed several days to allow flows to subside. Below is some additional information about the scheduled work:
