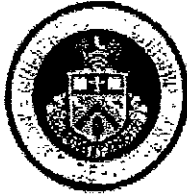

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHELTENHAM, CHAPTER 285 THEREOF, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, BY AMENDING CERTAIN STREET AND PARKING REGULATIONS.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham hereby ordains:

**SECTION 1.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article IV, entitled Schedule of Traffic Regulations, Section 285-43 thereof is hereby amended by **DELETING** the following:

SPRING AVENUE                      (15)    NO PARKING, east side, 255 feet north of  
Ashbourne Road to 275 feet north.

**SECTION 2.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article IV, entitled Schedule of Traffic Regulations, Section 285-43 thereof is hereby amended by **ADDING** the following:

SPRING AVENUE                      (15)    NO PARKING, east side, 241 feet north of  
Ashbourne Road to 287 feet north.

**SECTION 3.** That in all other respects Chapter 285 of the Code of the Township of Cheltenham is hereby approved and accepted as amended, and shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.

6/16 10:26AM Erlen Rd: Dwelling fire. Companies arrived with smoke from an occupied twin dwelling. Numerous hose lines were used to extinguish the fire which originated in the basement and caused portions of the first floor to fail. A working smoke detector alerted the occupants to the fire.  
 6/29 03:28AM Chelsea Rd: Dwelling fire. Companies arrived with heavy fire from the second floor of a twin dwelling. The early morning fire spread to the cockloft but was stopped before it affected the adjoining dwelling. The four occupants escaped. Three firefighters were injured fighting the fire.  
 6/27 09:24PM Glenside Ave: Vehicle Fire. Companies arrived with a well involved vehicle in the parking lot. The driver who was asleep in the vehicle, was awakened by a passerby. The driver was transported to the hospital for a check up.  
 6/30 11:00AM Willow Ave: Industrial Rescue. Companies extricated a worker whose hand became entrapped in a printing press. The freed worker was transported to a trauma center by Cheltenham EMS.

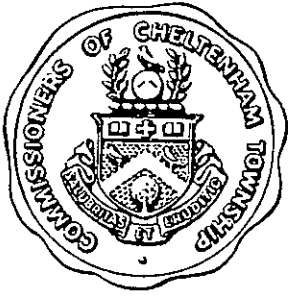

Attached please find our Operational Report for July of 2011, our financial, detail and statistical report for June of 2011.

The mobile data computer (MDC) was installed in 358-3 (our newest ambulance) and after months of issues and problems with the ambulance vendor, this ambulance is 100% in-service and operational.

We have begun the process of filling our open paramedic position. We plan to advertise during early August and pending vacations, complete interviews prior to Labor Day. Lt. James Herb has been doing an excellent job of filling our schedule in spite of having an open position and staff vacations. He has been able to fill all scheduled shifts.

During the month we had a record heat wave. The heat caused an increase in our regular call volume. Additionally, special preparations we made for rehab assignments should we be needed. Additional water and other cooling equipment was added to EMS vehicles, and all EMS officers were asked to respond to any major assignments. Fortunately none occurred.

I am pleased to report that during the past several months we have seen a significant increase in volunteer membership applications and activity. We currently have five volunteer applications and five active volunteers. This is one of the largest contingents of volunteers we have had in the last decade.

Due to a scheduled business trip I will be unable to attend the August Public Safety Meeting. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
