A regular meeting of the **PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE** was held tonight, Commissioner J. Andrew Sharkey, Chairman, presiding. Members present were Commissioners Hampton, McKeown, Norris, Portner and Simon. Also present was Ex-Officio Member Haywood.

Staff present were Patrick Duffy, Director of Engineering, Zoning and Inspections; Kenneth Hellendall, EMS Director; Kevin O'Brien, Deputy Chief of Police; Joseph O'Neill, Fire Marshal; and Bryan T. Havir, Acting Township Manager.

Also present was Joseph Bagley, Esq., Solicitor. A Public Attendance List is attached.

Mr. Sharkey called the meeting to order at 7:45 p.m.

1. Report of the Police Chief.
  - a. Deputy Chief O'Brien reviewed the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of September, 2012.
  - b. Deputy Chief O'Brien reviewed a proposed Ordinance to amend the Traffic Code as follows:

**DELETE:**

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD – 2 HOUR PARKING – south side, 85 feet to 225 feet east of Montgomery Avenue.

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD – 2 HOUR PARKING – both sides from Park Avenue to Montgomery Avenue.

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD – 12 HOUR PARKING – south side, 225 feet to 405 feet east of Montgomery Avenue.

MONTGOMERY AVENUE – 12 HOUR PARKING – east side, 83 feet to 103 feet north of High School Road.

ERLEN ROAD – HANDICAPPED PARKING – at 1729 Erlen Road.

HUBER STREET – NO PARKING – east side, from Mt. Carmel Avenue to 155 feet south.

MONTGOMERY AVENUE – NO PARKING – east side, High School Road to 83 feet north.

**ADD:**

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD – 2 HOUR PARKING – south side, Park Avenue to Montgomery Avenue.

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD – 2 HOUR PARKING – north side, Montgomery Avenue to 197 feet west.

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD – 2 HOUR PARKING – north side from Park Avenue to 89 feet east.

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD – 12 HOUR PARKING – 85 feet to 405 feet east of Montgomery Avenue.

BICKLEY ROAD – NO PARKING – east side, Toxony Avenue to 184 feet south of Glenside Avenue.

CEDAR ROAD – HANDICAPPED PARKING – east side, 46 feet north of Erlen Rd. This handicapped parking is for 1729 Erlen Road. This addition is effective for the duration period that this resident is eligible for a reserved handicapped parking space.

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD – LOADING AND UNLOADING ZONE – north side, 197 feet to 226 feet west from Montgomery Avenue.

HUBER STREET – NO PARKING, east side, Mt. Carmel Avenue to 130 feet south.

MONTGOMERY AVENUE – NO PARKING – east side, High School Road to 103 north.

WASHINGTON LANE – 45 MPH – Ashbourne Road to Township Line Road.

Deputy Chief O'Brien reported that most of the High School Road parking changes will help in accommodating customers and employees of the new Creekside Coop.

In response to a question from Mr. Haywood, Deputy Chief O'Brien stated that the No Parking sign restriction on Bickley Road and the mileage restriction on Washington Lane are currently in effect but not codified in Ordinance.

c. **Recommendation to the Board of Commissioners:** Upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Committee unanimously recommended to the Board of Commissioners the adoption of an Ordinance amending Chapter 285, thereof, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" as presented (see attached).

d. **Recommendation to the Board of Commissioners:** Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, the Committee unanimously recommended a Community Service Award to Kathryn Saltzman recognizing her fundraising efforts for a K9 vest for the Police Department's new K9.

e. Upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Committee unanimously accepted the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of September, 2012.

2. Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, the Committee unanimously accepted the Report of the Fire Marshal for the month of October, 2012.

3. Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, the Committee unanimously accepted the Report of the EMS Director for the month of October, 2012.

4. Mr. Hellendall reported on the status of Emergency Management Operations as it relates to Hurricane Sandy. The Committee unanimously commended all members of the Emergency Management Operations, Police, Fire, EMS, and Public Works Departments for their response and efforts.

Mr. Hellendall reported that he is considering initiating a Facebook page for Emergency Management Operations. Social medial is playing a significant role in informing citizens.

Mr. Simon noted problems with Comcast that were beyond the Township's control.

There being no further business, upon motion of Mr. McKeown and unanimously approved by the Committee, the meeting was adjourned.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHELTENHAM, CHAPTER 285 THEREOF, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, BY AMENDING CERTAIN STREET AND PARKING REGULATIONS.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham hereby ordains:

**SECTION 1.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article II, entitled Parking Meter Zones, Section 285-20 thereof is hereby amended by **DELETING** the following:

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD      South side      85 feet to 225 feet east of Montgomery Avenue.

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD      Both sides      Park Avenue to Montgomery Avenue.

**SECTION 2.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article II, entitled Parking Meter Zones, Section 285-21 thereof is hereby amended by **DELETING** the following:

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD      South side      225 feet to 405 feet east of Montgomery Avenue.

MONTGOMERY AVENUE East side      83 feet to 103 feet north of High School Road.

**SECTION 3.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article IV, entitled Schedule of Traffic Regulations, Section 285-43 thereof is hereby amended by **DELETING** the following:

ERLEN ROAD                      (9)      HANDICAPPED PARKING at 1729. This addition is effective for the duration period that this resident is eligible for a reserved handicapped parking space.

HUBER STREET                      (1)      NO PARKING, east side, Mt. Carmel Avenue to 155 feet south.

MONTGOMERY AVENUE (8)      NO PARKING, east side, High School Road to 83 feet north.

**SECTION 4.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article II, entitled Parking Meter Zones, Section 285-20 thereof is hereby amended by **ADDING** the following:

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD      South side      Park Avenue to Montgomery Avenue.

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD      North side      Montgomery Avenue to 197 feet west.

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD      North side      Park Avenue to 89 feet east.

**SECTION 5.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article II, entitled Parking Meter Zones, Section 285-21 thereof is hereby amended by **ADDING** the following:

HIGH SCHOOL ROAD      South side      85 feet to 405 feet east of Montgomery Avenue.

**SECTION 6.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article IV, entitled Schedule of Traffic Regulations, Section 285-43 thereof is hereby amended by **ADDING** the following:

**SECTION 7.** That in all other respects Chapter 285 of the Code of the Township of Cheltenham is hereby approved and accepted as amended, and shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 8.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.
