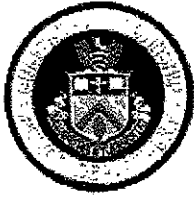

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHELTENHAM, CHAPTER 285 THEREOF, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, BY AMENDING CERTAIN STREET AND PARKING REGULATIONS.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham hereby ordains:

SECTION 1. The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article IV, entitled Schedule of Traffic Regulations, Section 285-43 thereof is hereby amended by **DELETING** the following:

MANOR ROAD (4) HANDICAPPED PARKING at 8220.

SECTION 2. The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article IV, entitled Schedule of Traffic Regulations, Section 285-43 thereof is hereby amended by **ADDING** the following:

WAVERLY ROAD (23) NO PARKING, north side, Keswick Avenue to Easton Road.

SECTION 3. That in all other respects Chapter 285 of the Code of the Township of Cheltenham is hereby approved and accepted as amended, and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.

- 8/5 2:11AM Georgian Rd: Companies arrived with heavy smoke showing from a single family residence. The fire was located in the basement and extinguished. The property sustained significant damage. Three persons escaped without injury.
- 8/15 6:12AM Cheltenham Ave: Commercial Building: Philadelphia and Cheltenham units arrived with a fire in a second floor office. The fire burned down into the office below before being extinguished.
- 8/19 Various Township wide: Companies responded to numerous storm related dispatches due to heavy rains.
- 8/27-8/29 Township wide: Hurricane Irene: Over 100 responses were made for calls from trees into structures, wires down, basement flooded and persons trapped by rising waters during the extremely heavy rains and winds that accompanied hurricane Irene.

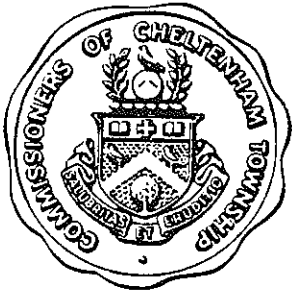

EMS staff continued to assist the emergency management team in cleanup and remediation from Hurricane Irene and Tropical storm Lee.
