A regular meeting of the **PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE** was held tonight, Commissioner J. Andrew Sharkey, Chairman, presiding. Members present were Commissioners McKeown (via telephone), Norris, Rappoport, and Simon. Also present was Ex-Officio Member Portner.

Staff present were Kenneth Hellendall, Emergency Management Coordinator; John J. Norris, Chief of Police; Timothy Schuck, Assistant Fire Marshal; Henry Sekawungu, Planning and Zoning Director; and Bryan T. Havir, Township Manager. Also present was Joseph M. Bagley, Esq., Township Solicitor. A Public Attendance List is attached.

Mr. Sharkey called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. He announced that the Commissioners held an Executive Session prior to the meeting to discuss potential litigation.

1. Chief Norris reviewed the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of June, 2014.

2. Upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Committee unanimously accepted the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of June, 2014.

3. Upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Committee unanimously accepted the Report of the Fire Marshal for the month of June, 2014.

4. Upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Committee unanimously accepted the Report of the EMS Director for the month of July, 2014.

5. The Committee discussed items on the Emergency Management Face Book page. Mr. Hellendall advised that Channel 10 will be reporting on the emergency back-up generators that were stolen from traffic lights this past winter. Said generators were used during power outages.

Upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Committee unanimously accepted the Report of the Emergency Management Coordinator for the month of July, 2014.

6. Under Report of the Township Manager – Mr. Havir gave an update on new radios that will be needed for the Police and Emergency Management Departments to maintain compatibility with the new county system. It is anticipated that 117 radios will be needed and will need to be acquired in 2016 at an estimated cost of +/- \$450,000.00.

Mr. Simon asked if the radio pricing was guaranteed. Mr. Hellendall responded that the radio pricing is contractual between the county and Motorola and guaranteed.

Mr. Sharkey asked Mr. Havir to share all information with the Fire Companies.

7. Under Old Business – None.

8. Under New Business – None.

9. Under Citizens Forum – Sheldon Shores, a Wyncote resident, was concerned that the “No Left Turn” traffic restriction at Maple Avenue and Washington Lane, which was erected during the Greenwood Avenue Bridge construction project, has not been removed. It is problematic for the residents. He also questioned why an orange barrel remained at Heacock Lane and Glenside Avenue. It has been in place for some time.

Mr. Havar advised that Township Staff will be meeting with PennDOT in the next week for a final site inspection meeting on the Greenwood Avenue Bridge project, and the “No Left Turn” traffic restriction will be discussed with PennDot. Mr. Shores will receive a response.

With respect to the orange construction barrel near the intersection of Glenside Avenue and Heacock Lane, Mr. Havar said he would check with the Public Works Superintendent to determine what repair work was taking place and how soon it will be completed.

There being no further business, upon motion of Mr. Sharkey, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
