Staff present were Alyson Elliott, Assistant Township Manager; Brian Hinson, Director of Parks and Recreation; Kevin O'Brien, Deputy Chief of Police; Joseph O'Neill, Fire Marshal; Henry Sekawungu, Director of Planning and Zoning; and Bryan T. Mr. Sharkey opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m. and announced prior to the meeting, the Commissioners held an Executive Session to discuss the purchase and/or lease of real property and litigation with The Bank of New York Mellon.

1. Deputy Chief O'Brien reviewed the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of October, 2015.
2. Deputy Chief O'Brien reported on the Police Promotional Ceremony scheduled for Tuesday, December 22, 2015, 10 a.m., at Glenside Hall. 6. Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, the Committee unanimously received the Report of the Emergency Management Coordinator for the month of November, 2015.

Under Report of the Township Manager: Mr. Havar reviewed the County's request for any overtime costs associated with the September 25-27, 2015 Papal visit by municipalities and the Township's submission of said requests. It has not yet been determined if there will be any reimbursement of these costs.

9. Under New Business: Mr. McKeown asked for an update on the recent robbery at the Dunkin Donuts on Cheltenham Avenue. Deputy Chief O'Brien responded that there is no new evidence but Cheltenham and Philadelphia Police Departments are actively working together on the case.
