A regular meeting of the **PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE** was held tonight, Commissioner J. Andrew Sharkey Chairman, presiding. Members present were Commissioners Holland, McKeown, Norris, Rappoport (via telephone), and Simon. Also present was Ex-Officio Member Portner.

Staff present were Kenneth Hellendall, EMS Director; John J. Norris, Chief of Police; Joseph O'Neill, Fire Marshal; Henry Sekawungu, Director of Planning/Zoning, and Bryan T. Havir, Township Manager. Also present was Joseph Bagley, Esq., Solicitor. A Public Attendance List is attached.

Mr. Sharkey called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and announced that prior to the meeting, the Commissioners held an Executive Session to discuss pending litigation.

1. Under Report of the Police Chief, Chief Norris reported the following:
 - a. He reviewed the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of December, 2014.
 - b. He recommended the following amendments to the Traffic Code, which were approved by Staff:

Add: Barker Road - Stop Street at Greenwood Avenue
Jefferson Avenue – Handicap Parking at 136 Jefferson Avenue
Butcher Street – Handicap Parking near 7317 Butcher Street

Recommendation to the Board of Commissioners: Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, the Committee unanimously recommended to the Board of Commissioners the adoption of an Ordinance amending Chapter 285 of the Traffic Code entitled “Vehicles and Traffic” (see attached).

Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, the Committee unanimously accepted the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of December, 2014.

2. Mr. O'Neill, accompanied by Darryl Harrison, Vice President of the Elkins Park Fire Company, gave an update on the Fire Companies' Long Range Plan. He noted that all subcommittees have been formed; the first objectives are due by this June; he acknowledged certain growing pains such as personnel issues.

Mr. McKeown asked if free smoke detectors are provided to residents. Mr. O'Neill responded that the Fire Companies to purchase and distribute for free smoke detectors that are now 10-year detectors and cost about \$40. They are available only for those residents in need.

Ms. Rappoport thanked the Fire Companies for their efforts in a recent fire at the Lynnewood Gardens Apartment complex.

Upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Committee unanimously accepted the Report of the Fire Marshal for the month of January, 2015.

3. Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, the Committee unanimously accepted the Report of the EMS Director for the month of January, 2015.

4. Mr. Hellendall reported on two (2) recent spills in the Tookany Creek in the vicinity of Wyncote. The Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP") was advised, and it investigated the matter. The spillage was traced to a contractor working in Jenkintown that was cleaning equipment with chemicals. DEP has ordered remediation by the contractor and is monitoring the situation. In response to a question from Mr. Norris, Mr. Hellendall stated that there is no responsibility or cost to Cheltenham.

5. Upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Committee unanimously accepted the Report of the Emergency Management Coordinator for the month of January, 2015.

6. Report of the Township Manager – None.

7. Old Business – None.

8. New Business – None.

There being no further business, upon motion of Mr. Portner, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHELTENHAM,
CHAPTER 285 THEREOF, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, BY AMENDING CERTAIN
STREET AND PARKING REGULATIONS.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham hereby ordains:

SECTION 1. The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article II, entitled Parking Meter Zones, Section 285-20 thereof is hereby amended by **ADDING** the following:

SECTION 3. That in all other respects Chapter 285 of the Code of the Township of Cheltenham is hereby approved and accepted as amended, and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.
