2/2 9:45AM Township Line Rd & Glen Rd: Vehicle Rescue. Companies arrived with on person entrapped in a head on collision that involved numerous vehicles.
 2/14 4:18PM Barker Road: Assisted Living Facility: Companies responding for an automatic fire alarm found smoke throughout the basement of an assisted living facility from an extinguished cooking fire. Employees had used a hand held extinguisher prior to activating the built-in fire suppression system. Companies ventilated the building for an extended period. The fire was confined to the equipment.
 2/20 6:24PM Elizabeth Rd: Dwelling fire. Companies responding for a reported basement fire arrived with smoke showing from the first and second floors. The fire was confined to the heater. The dwelling was uninhabitable due to soot throughout. One occupant was transported to the hospital for check up.
 Various Elevator Rescue: Companies responded on three occasions to apartment houses and an office building for occupants inside stuck elevators. Companies respond routinely to free persons in stuck elevators throughout the year.

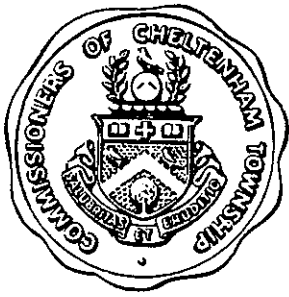
