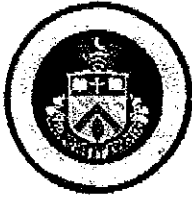

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHELTENHAM, CHAPTER 285 THEREOF, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, BY AMENDING CERTAIN STREET AND PARKING REGULATIONS.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham hereby ordains:

**SECTION 1.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article IV, entitled Schedule of Traffic Regulations, Section 285-43 thereof is hereby amended by **DELETING** the following:

**SECTION 2.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article IV, entitled Schedule of Traffic Regulations, Section 285-43 thereof is hereby amended by **ADDING** the following:

**SECTION 3.** That in all other respects Chapter 285 of the Code of the Township of Cheltenham is hereby approved and accepted as amended, and shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.

**Summary of Significant Incidents**

- 12/9 12:57PM Church & Rices Mill Rds: Vehicle Fire. Companies arrived with a well involved vehicle fire at the scene of a multi vehicle crash. Numerous injured were transported by EMS.
- 12/14 7:22PM Cheltenham High School: Companies dispatched to an automatic fire alarm found a fire in a bathroom. The fire had been intentionally set. Staff at the school safely evacuated the occupants attending a sports event and attended to the fire. Damage was minimal and confined to the bathroom
- 12/25 1:02PM Einstein Hospital at Elkins Park: Companies dispatched to an automatic fire alarm arrived with smoke filling a first floor corridor. The cause was quickly located and confined to equipment in an imaging suite. Crews determined no patients would need evacuation. Crews ventilated the building of smoke.

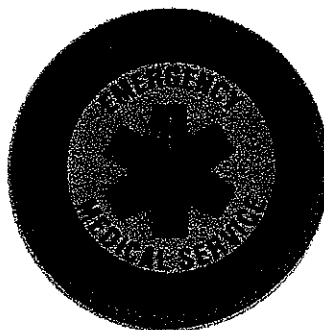
