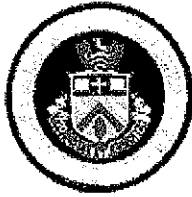

Summary of Significant Incidents

- 3/6 11:05PM Old York Rd, Abington: Hirise Apartment Fire. Three Cheltenham companies responded on a two alarm hirise building fire in Abington Township. Apparatus necessary to mitigate an incident are automatically dispatched based on need at a scene. Fires in hirise buildings are usually high challenge events as smoke and heat can quickly cut off escape.. This fire was contained to one upper story apartment.
- 3/27 2:25AM Ronaele Dr: Dwelling. Companies dispatched to a brush fire arrived with the fire having extended to a dwelling. Additional companies were dispatched to assist. The fire caused damaged to the basement and first floor of the dwelling. The fire occurred during high winds in extremely dry conditions. Numerous wind driven brush fires were responded to during this period.
- 3/31 2:22PM Willow Grove Avenue & Sandy Hill Road: Vehicle Rescue. Companies extricated a victim entrapped in the wreckage of a vehicle crash.

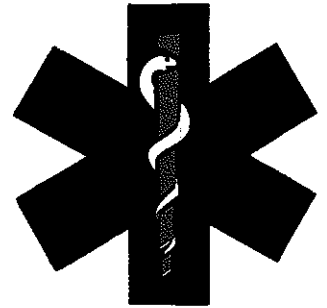

Attached please find our Operational Report for April of 2012, our financial, detail and statistical report for March of 2012.

We have identified and hope to hire a new paramedic during the month of May. This will bring us up to full staff as we approach vacation season. We hope that several weeks into May, he will be self-sufficient and we will be able to reduce the number of part-time hours currently be expended. This hire will also help us in reducing overtime shifts.

During the month EMS assisted the fire department during a building fire at the Towers of Wyncote. Approximately six-hundred people were evacuated. A total of eleven ambulances were committed to either the fire or covering The Township. EMS provided a rehabilitation station for firefighters while transporting five injured residents to the hospital. EMS personnel also acted at the liaison to the Red Cross who assisted residents who could not return to their apartments. Thank you letters were sent to the EMS services (from as far away as Plymouth Township and Lansdale) that assisted our staff. Our regular staff, off duty and over time personnel assisted other Township agencies and the Philadelphia Fire Department during the burial (at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery) of Philadelphia Fire Fighter Daniel Sweeney who died while fighting a fire on April 9th.

I will be on vacation the week of April 29th, 2012 and will be unable to attend your meeting. Please contact me if you have any questions.
