**ORDINANCE NO.**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHELTENHAM, CHAPTER 285 THEREOF, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, BY AMENDING CERTAIN STREET AND PARKING REGULATIONS.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham hereby ordains:

**SECTION 1.** The Code of the Township of Cheltenham, Chapter 285, Article IV, entitled Schedule of Traffic Regulations, Section 285-43 thereof is hereby amended by **ADDING** the following:

BICKLEY                      (16)    HANDICAPPED PARKING at 149. This addition is effective for the duration period that this resident is eligible for a reserved handicapped parking space.

**SECTION 2.** That in all other respects Chapter 285 of the Code of the Township of Cheltenham is hereby approved and accepted as amended, and shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.

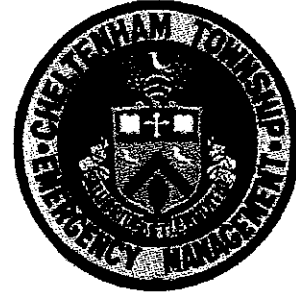

Attached please find the report of The Deputy Emergency Management Coordinator. In addition to her report, we participated in the following activities:

- Our emergency management flood vehicle purchased from State Surplus had a mechanical failure. Through the diligent efforts of Tom Walsh of the Public Works garage the part was located and is in the process of shipping to us. The vehicle will be back in service shortly.
- We have been working with SEPTA on Radio Inter-Operability System (RIOS). This system (being donated to us by SEPTA – including training) has been installed at our EOC. We will be trained on RIOS during September. Once operational we will have the ability to interconnect multiple radio systems
- In conjunction with Deputy Coordinator Kirschner we are on the Eastern Montgomery County's EDITS planning committee. This is a bi-annual training that is presented for the emergency service every other year. EDITS 2012 will be held in October and approximately ten Township emergency services personnel will attend.
