The regular meeting of the **TWINNING COMMITTEE** for October 2018 was held tonight. Members present were James McCann III, and Mary Washington. Staff present was Brian Hinson, Director of Parks and Recreation.

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. Upon motion of Mrs. Washington, and approved by the Committee, the minutes of the June 6, 2018 meeting were accepted.
3. **2018 Lottery Report.** Mr. McCann reported one winner in June for a total payout of \$25, three winners in July for a payout of \$75, three winners in August for a payout of \$75, and five winners in September for a payout of \$250. Mr. McCann stated there was a check written for the lottery permit application (Small Games of Chance License). Mr. McCann stated that the paper work was signed by him, notarized and sent to Montgomery County. Mr. McCann said he will need quotes for 1,000 lottery tickets which have to be numbered # 000- # 999 and quotes for new lottery envelopes. He said the dates on the envelopes for year 2019 will have to change because of the holidays. Mr. Hinson will investigate who the present printer is for Twinning and get quotes from other printers. Mrs. Washington asked when the Committee will start sending out information again for the lottery. Mr. McCann said the mailings will take place in November. He also mentioned that there are slips stating “thank you for supporting” and a letter of “thank you” after winning.
