The regular meeting of the **TWINNING COMMITTEE** for June 2018 was held tonight. Members present were James McCann III, William Chambres and Mary Washington. Staff present was Brian Hinson, Director of Parks and Recreation.

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:31 p.m.
2. Upon motion of Mrs. Washington, and approved by the Committee, the minutes of the February 7, 2018 meeting were accepted.
3. **2018 Lottery Report.** Mr. McCann reported six winners in January for a total payout of \$175, three winners in February for a payout of \$75, four winners in March for a payout of \$100, two winners in April for a payout of \$75 and five winners in May for a payout of \$150.
4. **Project Reports.**

A. Exchanges:

- i. Scouting Links:* Mr. McCann said the Scouts are on break for the summer. He discussed the Boy Scouts of America's consideration of accepting female members into their troops. Cub Scouts are not accepting girls in their troop at this time.
 - ii. Historical Commission/Society Link:* Mr. McCann received a newsletter from the UK Society and sent the most recent Historical Commission e-newsletter to the UK Society. Mrs. Washington asked Mr. McCann for an address so she can send the Old York Road Historical Society Newsletters to the UK Society as well.
 - iii. School Link:* Mr. McCann visited Cheltenham Elementary. He shared books and albums from his last visit to the Cheltenham UK, along with information about the Twinning Committee and the Township's historical connection with Cheltenham UK. He also shared information about the history of the Richard Wall House.
5. **Old Business.** Mr. McCann said he missed Nancy Gibson's retirement and shared a picture of her from a past celebration for Camp William Penn at the La Mott Community Center. He will have it framed and present it to her as a retirement gift.

The Committee was reminded that Twinning Committee Meetings will be held on the 2nd Thursdays at 6:30 p.m. prior to the Historical Commission meeting which starts at 7:30 p.m. at the Carriage House starting in September.

6. **New Business.** Mr. Chambres said that he will be attending a meeting of local historians at St. Paul's Church on Wednesday, June 27 at 6:30 p.m. to share information about the Twinning Committee in hopes that he can garner additional members for the Twinning Committee. This will be the first time such a meeting will take place.
7. There being no further business, upon motion of Ms. Washington, and approved by Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
