of the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township

Whereas, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, with tremendous pride and admiration, salutes the **PRIMEX GARDEN CENTER**, of 435 West Glenside Avenue in Glenside, on the occasion of its 75th Anniversary; and


Whereas, The Green family launched Primex Mills in 1943 and the retail store in 1956, a first of its kind in the area. The business overcame devastating fires in 1978 and 1981, eventually replacing the damaged structures with a tropical greenhouse and nursery. The store was completely renovated in 1990 and a second greenhouse added in 2000. A shade structure and sales barn added in 2010 were the latest improvements to the ever expanding enterprise; and

Whereas, The third and fourth generations of Green family members now operating the business continue to follow founder Bill Green's example of community outreach. The **PRIMEX GARDEN CENTER** hosts the Glenside Farmers Market during the winter and serves as a drop-off site for an area organic farm cooperative. In addition, it donates plants, seeds, tools and staff time to support area gardening projects and partners with like-minded organizations like community gardens and educational institutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, duly convened in regular session this Twenty-Eighth Day of March, A.D., 2018, does hereby officially salute the **PRIMEX GARDEN CENTER** for its 75 years of contributions to the Glenside community and extends its best wishes for many more years of success. It is further directed that this Resolution be spread in full upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy thereof be conveyed the Green family.
