A regular meeting of the **PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE** was held tonight, Harvey Portner, Chairman, presiding. Members present were Commissioners Muldawer, Sharkey, Simon and Swavola. Also present was Ex-Officio Member Greenwald. Staff present were Bryan T. Havir, Assistant Township Manager; John J. Norris, Chief of Police; Joseph O'Neill, Fire Marshal; Ruth Littner Shaw, Main Street Manager; and David G. Kraynik, Township Manager. A Public Attendance List is attached.

Mr. Portner called the meeting to order.

1. Chief Norris reviewed the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of November, 2008.

2. Chief Norris reviewed a proposed Ordinance amending the Traffic Code. Said ordinance adds a 40-MPH speed limit on Easton Road between Cheltenham Avenue and Limekiln Pike.

He reported that the speed limit is being added for this newly constructed area of said roadway by PennDOT as a result of the Route 309 construction project.

3. Upon motion of Mr. Greenwald, and unanimously approved by the Committee, it is recommended to the Board of Commissioners the adoption of an ordinance amending Chapter 285 thereof, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" (*see attachment*).

4. Upon motion of Mr. Greenwald, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of November, 2008, were accepted.

5. Upon motion of Mr. Portner, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the Report of the Fire Marshal for the month of December, 2008 was accepted.

6. Upon motion of Mr. Portner, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the Report of the EMS Director for the month of December, 2008 was accepted.

7. **Under New Business:** Mr. Swavola asked if recent weather conditions contributed to any problems. Chief Norris reported that the Public Works Department was treating the roads, and there have been no problems.

There being no further business, upon motion of Mr. Swavola, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the meeting was adjourned.
