A regular meeting of the **PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE** was held tonight, Morton J. Simon, Jr. presiding. Members present were Commissioners Muldawer, Sharkey, and Swavola. Also present was Ex-Officio Member Greenwald. Staff present were Joseph M. Bagley, Esq., Wisler Pearlstine, LLC; Bryan T. Havir, Assistant Township Manager; David M. Lynch, Director of Engineering, Zoning & Inspections; John J. Norris, Chief of Police; Kevin O'Brien, Deputy Chief of Police; Joseph O'Neill, Fire Marshal; Ruth Littner Shaw, Main Street Manager; and David G. Kraynik, Township Manager. Mr. Simon called the meeting to order.

1. Deputy Chief Norris reviewed the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of August, 2009.
2. Chief Norris reported that he would like to modify the Police Department's application for a Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). Said grant application was originally for funds to purchase automobile license plate readers. Two (2) readers have been donated, and the Police Department wants to amend the application to purchase building security cameras. The Committee unanimously approved said request.
3. Upon motion of Mr. Greenwald, unanimously approved by the Committee, the Police Activity/Community Policing Unit, Clearance and Juvenile Contact Reports for the month of August, 2009, were accepted.
4. Upon motion of Mr. Greenwald, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the Report of the Fire Marshal for the month of September, 2009 was accepted.
5. Upon motion of Mr. Greenwald, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the Report of the EMS Director for the month of September, 2009 was accepted.

6. Upon motion of Mr. Greenwald, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the Report of the Emergency Management Coordinator for the month of September, 2009 was accepted.

7. Mr. Kraynik asked that the Committee consider recommending a Resolution honoring the Auxiliary Police Unit on the occasion of its 55th Anniversary.

8. Upon motion of Mr. Simon, and unanimously approved by the Committee, it is recommended to the Board of Commissioners the adoption of a Resolution honoring the Auxiliary Police Unit on the occasion of its 55th Anniversary. Said Resolution will be presented to the Unit at its banquet on October 24, 2009.

There being no further business, upon motion of Mr. Greenwald, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the meeting was adjourned and the Commissioners commenced an Executive Session to discuss personnel matters.
